

(7296.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT SADDLERS AND HARNESS AND BAG MAKERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Saddlers and Harness and Bag Makers' award, dated the 25th day of May, 1922, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxiii, p. 257; and in the matter of an application to amend the said award by the Auckland Saddle, Bridle, Harness, Collar, and Bag Manufacturers' Industrial Union of Employers, and the Auckland Saddlers, Harnessmakers, Bag-makers, Collarmakers, and Bridle-cutters' Society Industrial Union of Workers.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act, 1921-22, and with the consent of the parties, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say:—

1. By deleting the figures "£2 2s. 6d." in clause 9 of the said award, and substituting therefor the figures "£2 5s."
2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the date hereof.
