

(7359.) SOUTHLAND PROVINCIAL DISTRICT (EXCEPT STEWART ISLAND) PRIVATE-HOTEL, RESTAURANT, TEA-, LUNCHEON-, AND REFRESHMENT-ROOM, AND OYSTER-SALOON EMPLOYEES. — ORDER ADDING PARTIES TO AWARD.
