

(7404.) AUCKLAND (TEN-MILES RADIUS) LOCAL BODIES'  
LABOURERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Auckland (Ten-miles Radius) Local Bodies' Labourers' award dated the 6th day of November, 1922, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxiii, p. 832; and in the matter of an application by the Auckland and Suburban Local Bodies' Labourers and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers for an amendment of the said award.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by section 92 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say:—

1. Subclause (a) of clause 4 of the said award is hereby deleted, and the following provision is substituted therefor:—

“(a.) The recognized holidays shall be New Year's Day, 29th January, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, Sovereign's Birth-

day, Labour Day, Christmas Day, Boxing Day, and the Saturday upon which the union's annual picnic is held ; and no deduction from wages shall be made in respect of such holidays : Provided that casual hands shall not be entitled to any pay for any of such holidays until after three months' service."

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the date hereof.
