

(7161.) WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT (EXCEPT WELLINGTON TWENTY-FIVE MILES RADIUS) BUILDERS' AND GENERAL LABOURERS.—ORDER ADDING PARTIES TO AWARD.
