

(7216.) OTAGO PROVINCIAL DISTRICT GENERAL ELECTRICAL WORKERS.—ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908; and in the matter of the Otago Provincial District General Electrical Workers' Award, dated the 28th day of February, 1922, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxiii, p. 39.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section 92 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

By adding the following subclause to clause 14 :—

“(c.) Nothing herein contained shall prevent an employer from employing any person who is a member of the Dunedin Branch of the Amalgamated Society of Engineers, although he is not a member of the union.”
