

(7217.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT HARVEST HANDS, THRESHING-MILL AND CHAFFCUTTER EMPLOYEES.— ORDER AMENDING AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments ; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Industrial District Harvest Hands, Threshing-mill and Chaffcutter Employees' award, dated the 27th day of February, 1922, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxiii, p. 27.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section 92 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and section 5 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act, 1921-22, and of the power reserved by the Court on the making of the said award, and with the consent of the parties thereto, this Court, being

of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

By adding the following subclause to clause 3 :—

“(d.) The millowner shall pay to the band-cutter or other worker who steers the engine and assists the driver in cleaning and oiling the mill an additional sum of £1 5s. per week for such services.”
