

## WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

### (7218.) WELLINGTON GENERAL LABOURERS.—SUPPLEMENTARY INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT WITH WELLINGTON CITY COUNCIL.

THIS industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments, this 13th day of June, 1922, between the Wellington Builders' and General Labourers' Industrial Union of Workers, a duly registered industrial union having its registered office in the City of Wellington (hereinafter called "the union") of the one part, and the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Wellington (hereinafter called "the Corporation") of the other part :

Whereas this industrial agreement is supplemental to an industrial agreement dated the 11th day of April, 1921, made between the parties hereto, and recorded in the Book of Awards, Vol. xxii, folio 787 : And whereas it has been agreed by the parties hereto that the said agreement be varied : Now, therefore, it is hereby agreed and declared by and between the parties hereto that the said agreement be varied from the date hereof in manner following, that is to say : By deleting clause 12 thereof and substituting therefor the following :—

#### *“ Preference.*

“(a.) If the Corporation shall hereafter engage any worker coming within the scope of the said agreement of the 11th day of April, 1921, who shall not be a member of the union, and who shall not become a member thereof within fourteen days after his engagement and remain such member, the Corporation shall dismiss such worker from its service if requested to do so by the union, provided there is then a member of the union equally qualified to perform the particular work required to be done, and ready and willing to undertake the same.

“(b.) The provisions of the foregoing clause shall operate only if and so long as the rules of the union shall permit any worker coming within the scope of the said agreement of the 11th day of April, 1921, of good character and sober habits, to become a member of the union

upon payment of an entrance fee not exceeding 5s., upon a written application, without ballot or other election, and to continue a member upon payment of subsequent contributions not exceeding 6d. per week.

“(c.) When the Corporation engages any worker who is not a member of the union the Corporation shall within three days notify the secretary of the union of such engagement.”
