

(7112.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND TRAWLER EMPLOYEES.—ORDER
ADDING PARTY TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Trawler Employees award, dated the 27th day of October, 1920, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, folio 2012.
