

(7648.) OAMARU, HAMPDEN, AND WAITAKI COUNTY GROCERS'
ASSISTANTS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of a joint application by the parties for amendment of the Oamaru, Hampden, and Waitaki Grocers' Assistants' award, dated the 30th day of November, 1922, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxiii, p. 1039.

Friday, the 2nd day of November, 1923.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties to the Oamaru, Hampden, and Waitaki County Grocers' Assistants' award, dated the 30th day of November, 1922, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxiii, p. 1039, which application was filed herein on the 8th day of August, 1923, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said parties, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 5 of the Industrial Conciliation

and Arbitration Amendment Act, 1921, and of every other power in that behalf thereto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order that the said award shall be and it is hereby amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Subclause (c) of clause 6 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following substituted therefor:—

“(c.) One holiday of one week on full pay shall be granted to each worker under this award on completion of each year of service, and at a time to be mutually arranged between the employer and the worker.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the 12th day of November, 1923.
