

(7904.) AUCKLAND (FIFTEEN-MILES RADIUS) AERATED-WATER AND  
CONDIMENT, ETC., WORKERS.—ADDING PARTY TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Auckland (Fifteen-miles Radius) Aerated-water and Condiment, &c., Workers' award, dated the 26th day of May, 1922, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxiii, p. 240.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the Auckland (Fifteen-miles Radius) Aerated-water and Condiment, &c., Workers' award, dated the 26th day of May, 1922, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxiii, p. 240, which application was filed herein on the 2nd day of July, 1924, and with the consent of the undermentioned

firm, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and the firm hereinafter named, this Court doth order as follows :—

1. That Messrs. Irvine and Stevenson (Limited), St. George Manufacturing Company, Hepburn and Napier Streets, Auckland, be and it is hereby added as a party to the said award as from the day of the date hereof.

2. That with the consent of the said union and the said firm the following special conditions shall apply in respect of this order : Where female workers are employed by the said firm at packing fruit, and food products other than fruit, such workers shall be paid the following rates of wages, viz. : For the first six months, £1 per week ; for the second six months, £1 2s. 6d. per week ; for the second year, £1 5s. per week ; for the third year, £1 12s. 6d. per week ; for the fourth year, £2 per week ; and thereafter £2 4s. per week.
