

(7905.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT GROCERS' ASSISTANTS
AND DRIVERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments: And in the matter of a joint application by the parties for amendment of the Northern Industrial District Grocers' Assistants and Drivers' award, dated the 3rd day of May, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxv, p. 303.

Monday, the 22nd day of September, 1924.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties to the Northern Industrial District Grocers' Assistants and Drivers' award, dated the 3rd day of May, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxv, p. 303, which application was filed herein on the 9th day of September, 1924; and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said parties, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 5 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act, 1921, and of every other power in that behalf thereto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order that the said award shall be and it is hereby amended in manner following, that is to say:—

1. The following paragraph shall be added to clause 2 (a) of the said award:—

“ All shops carrying on any of the businesses covered by this award, within the Borough of Taumarunui, shall be closed at the following hours: On Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays, at 5.15 p.m.; on Wednesdays, at 12 noon; and on Saturdays, at 9 p.m.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
