1. That, notwithstanding the provisions of clause 12 of the said award, the Timaru Borough Council be and it is hereby added as a

party to the said award.

2. That, with respect to the Timaru Borough Council, the words "Christchurch City Council" wherever they occur in clause 5 of the said award shall be read as if they were the words "Timaru Borough Council."

3. That, with respect to the Timaru Borough Council, clause 5 (b) of the said award shall be read as if the word "Timaru" had been inserted before the words "Show Day."

4. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of

the date hereof.
