

(7740.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT COAL-MINES.—AMEND-
MENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of a joint application by the parties for amendment of the Northern Industrial District Coal-mines award, dated the 20th day of December, 1921, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxii, p. 1899.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties to the Northern Industrial District Coal-mines award, dated the 20th day of December, 1921, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxii, p. 1899, which application was filed herein on the 8th day of April, 1924, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 5

of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act, 1921, and of every other power in that behalf thereto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order that the said award shall be and it is hereby amended in manner following, that is to say :—

1. Clause 38 of Part I of the said award shall be deleted, and the following substituted therefor :—

“ Term of Award.

“ 38. This award shall come into force on the 7th day of January, 1922, and shall continue in force until the 12th day of April, 1924.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
