(8003.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT PLUMBERS AND GAS-FITTERS.—AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Plumbers and Gasfitters' apprenticeship order, dated the 26th day of September, 1924.

Tuesday, the 30th day of December, 1924.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on the Court by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, this Court, upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the parties to the Northern Industrial District Plumbers and Gasfitters' apprenticeship order dated the 26th day of September, 1924, and being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said order, doth hereby order that the said order shall be amended in manner following, that is to say :—

1. Clause 6 of the said order shall be amended by inserting the following words after the word "apprentice" in the fifth line thereof: "provided that the employer or one member of the firm is a registered plumber who himself works substantially at the trade."

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
