

(8034.) WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT BESPOKE TAILORS.—
AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.— In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Bespoke Tailors Apprenticeship Order, dated the 21st day of August, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxv, p. 784.

Monday, the 29th day of December, 1924.

WHEREAS, on the application of the Apprenticeship Committee set up for the Wanganui Subdistrict in the Wellington Industrial District,

an apprenticeship order has this day been made prescribing the conditions of apprenticeship in the bespoke-tailoring industry in the said subdistrict: And whereas it is necessary that the apprenticeship order made on the 21st day of August, 1924, prescribing the conditions of apprenticeship in the said industry in the Wellington Industrial District should be amended accordingly: Now, therefore, the Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That clause 1 of the said apprenticeship order be deleted and the following clause substituted therefor:—

“The locality in which this order shall have effect is the Wellington Industrial District except that part which is bounded by a straight line drawn from the mouth of the Patea River to Pipiriki, up the Wanganui River to the 39th parallel, along the 39th parallel to the Ruahine Ranges, along the Ruahine Ranges to the Kawhatu Stream, thence the Kawhatu Stream to the Rangitikei River, continuing along the Rangitikei River to the sea.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the 1st day of January, 1925.
