

(8042.) WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT GROCERS' ASSISTANTS
AND DRIVERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of a joint application by the parties for amendment of the Wellington Industrial District Grocers' Assistants and Drivers' award, dated the 13th day of July, 1923, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxiv, p. 485.

Monday, the 22nd day of December, 1924.

UPON reading the application of the parties to the Wellington Industrial Grocers' Assistants and Drivers' award, dated the 13th day of July, 1923, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxiv, p. 485, which application was filed herein on the 20th day of November, 1924; and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said parties; this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 5 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act, 1921, and of every other power in that behalf thereto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order that the said award shall be and it is hereby amended in manner following, that is to say:—

1. The following paragraph shall be added to clause 1 (c) of the said award:—

“ All grocers' shops carrying on business within a radius of thirty miles from the General Post Office at Wellington shall be closed from

the hour of 7 a.m. on Easter Saturday: Provided that this shall not affect any occupier to whom the Court has granted or shall hereafter grant exemption from the closing-hours provisions of the award.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
