

(7813.) NORTHERN, TARANAKI, WELLINGTON, NELSON, CANTERBURY, AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS CARPENTERS AND JOINERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Nelson, Canterbury and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts Carpenters and Joiners' award dated the 19th day of July, 1923, and recorded in Book of Awards Vol. xxiv, p. 416.

Thursday, the 26th day of June, 1924.

UPON reading the application of the Timaru Carpenters' Industrial Union of Workers, filed herein on the 6th day of June, 1924; and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the association of workers party to the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Nelson, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts Carpenters and Joiners' award dated the 19th day of July, 1923, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxiv, p. 416, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers reserved by clause 10 (e) of the said award, and being satisfied that the rules of the said union

are in conformity with the provisions of clause 10 of the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be and it is hereby amended in manner following, that is to say,—

1. The Timaru Carpenters' Industrial Union of Workers shall be and it is hereby added as a party to the said award.

2. Subclause (d) of clause 10 of the said award shall be deleted, and the following substituted therefor: "The term 'the union' shall mean the Timaru Carpenters' Industrial Union of Workers, or the local union affiliated to the New Zealand Amalgamated Society of Carpenters and Joiners' Industrial Association of Workers, as the case may be."

3. Subclause (e) of clause 10 of the said award shall be amended by deleting the words "and the Timaru Carpenters' Industrial Union of Workers" in the second and third lines, and by deleting the word "unions" in the fourth line and substituting therefor the word "union."

4. This order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
