

(7817.) KAITANGATA COAL-MINES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of a joint application by the parties for amendment of the Kaitangata Coal-mines award dated the 21st day of November, 1921, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxii, p. 1575.

Tuesday, the 15th day of July, 1924.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties to the Kaitangata Coal-mines award dated the 21st day of November, 1921, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxii, p. 1575, which application was filed herein on the 14th day of July, 1924; and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said parties, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 5 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act, 1921, and of every other power in that behalf thereto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order that the said award shall be and it is hereby amended in manner following, that is to say:—

1. Clause 2 of Part III of the said award shall be deleted, and the following substituted therefor:—

“2. This award shall come into force on the 1st day of December, 1921, and shall remain in force until the 24th day of July, 1924.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
