

(8211.) AUCKLAND ABATTOIR ASSISTANTS.—AMENDMENT OF
AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of a joint application by the parties for amendment of the Auckland Abattoir Assistants' award, dated the 30th day of December, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxv, p. 1485.

Friday, the 8th day of May, 1925.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties to the Auckland Abattoir Assistants' award, dated the 30th day of December, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxv, p. 1485, which application was filed herein on the 29th day of April, 1925; and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said parties, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 5 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act, 1921, and of every other power in that behalf thereto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order that the said award shall be and it is hereby amended in manner following, that is to say :—

1. That the amending order dated the 18th day of March, 1925, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxvA, p. 195, be set aside.

2. That the following subclauses be added to clause 3, sub-clause (g), of the said award :—

“ (g.) (1.) For all pigs singed 2d. per pig shall be paid in addition to the above rates.”

“ (g.) (2.) For all pigs mechanically scudded 4d. per pig shall be deducted from the above rates.”

3. That this order shall be deemed to have operated and taken effect as from the 5th day of January, 1925.
