

(8319.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND PLUMBERS AND GASFITTERS.—
AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Plumbers and Gasfitters' apprenticeship order, dated the 22nd day of December, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 1752.

Wednesday, the 12th day of August, 1925.

WHEREAS on the application of the Apprenticeship Committee set up for the Oamaru Subdistrict, in the Otago and Southland Industrial

District, an apprenticeship order has this day been made prescribing the conditions of apprenticeship in the plumbing and gasfitting industry in the said subdistrict: And whereas it is necessary that the apprenticeship order made on the 22nd day of December, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 1752, prescribing the conditions of apprenticeship in the said industry in the Otago and Southland Industrial District, should be amended accordingly: Now, therefore, the Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That clause 1 of the said apprenticeship order, dated the 22nd day of December, 1924, be deleted, and the following clause substituted therefor:—

“1. The locality in which this order shall have effect is the Otago and Southland Industrial District, except that portion thereof lying within a radius of ten miles from the Chief Post-office in Oamaru.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the 24th day of August, 1925.
