

(8375.) NORTHERN, TARANAKI, WELLINGTON, CANTERBURY, AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS TEA-ROOMS AND RESTAURANTS EMPLOYEES.—STRIKING OUT PARTY FROM AWARD.
