- In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern, Wellington, Nelson, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts Painters and Decorators' award, dated the 5th day of May, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 428.

Upon reading the application of the Wellington Amalgamated Society of Painters and Decorators' Industrial Union of Workers, party to the Northern, Wellington, Nelson, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts Painters and Decorators' award, dated the 5th day of May, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 428, which application was filed herein on the 9th day of November, 1925, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the said union and such of the persons, firms, and companies hereinafter named as appeared either in person or by their representative duly appointed, this Court doth order as follows:—

1. That the undermentioned be and they are hereby added as parties to the said award as from the day of the date hereof:—

Young, F. W., Signwriter, 66 Moxham Avenue, Wellington.

2. That the provisions of the said award shall not apply to the Eastbourne Borough Council in respect of painting-work on its ferry-steamers performed by seamen in the employ of the said Council, provided that such painting-work is such as is ordinarily performed by seamen.

3. That the provisions of the said award shall not affect any female employee of V. G. Shepherd, commercial artist, of Wellington, so long as such female employees are engaged on work similar to that at

present performed by them.
