

(8104.) CANTERBURY TAILORS AND TAILORESSES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Canterbury Tailors and Tailoresses' award, dated the 28th day of November, 1924, and recorded in the Book of Awards, Vol. xxv, p. 1244.

Wednesday, the 4th day of February, 1925.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section 92 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Canterbury Tailors and Tailoresses' award, dated the 28th day of November, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxv, p. 1244, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award be amended in manner following, that is to say:—

1. Subclause (b) of clause 2 of the said award is hereby amended by deleting the figure "5" where it first appears therein and substituting the figure "6."
2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
