(8469.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT FURNITURE TRADE.— AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Furniture Trade apprenticeship order, dated the 16th day of October, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 1145.

Monday, the 21st day of December, 1925.

Whereas, on the application of the Apprenticeship Committee set up for the Gisborne Judicial District, in the Northern Industrial District, an apprenticeship order has this day been made prescribing the conditions of apprenticeship in the furniture trade in the said Gisborne Judicial District: And whereas it is necessary that the apprenticeship order made on the 16th day of October, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 1145, prescribing the conditions of apprenticeship in the said trade in the Northern Industrial District, should be amended accordingly: Now, therefore, the Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That clause 1 of the said apprenticeship order dated the 16th day of October, 1924, be deleted, and the following clause sub-

stituted therefor:

"1. The locality in which this order shall have effect is the Northern Industrial District except that part thereof which is included in the Gisborne Judicial District."

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the 4th

day of January, 1926.
