

(8483.) WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT ELECTRICAL WORKERS.—AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Electrical Workers' apprenticeship order, dated the 20th day of August, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 775.

Wednesday, the 16th day of December, 1925.

WHEREAS on the application of the Apprenticeship Committee set up for the Masterton district, in the Wellington Industrial District, an apprenticeship order has this day been made prescribing the conditions of apprenticeship in the electrical trade in the Masterton district; and whereas it is necessary that the apprenticeship order made on the 20th day of August, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 775, prescribing the conditions of apprenticeship in the said trade in the Wellington Industrial District, should be amended accordingly; now, therefore, the Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That clause 1 of the said apprenticeship order dated the 20th day of August, 1924, be deleted, and the following clause substituted therefor:—

“1. The locality in which this order shall have effect is the Wellington Industrial District except that portion thereof which is bounded on the north by the Hawke's Bay Provincial District, on the east by the sea, on the west by the Tararua and Rimutaka Ranges, and on the south by the sea.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the 28th day of December, 1925.
