

(8494.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT  
THRESHING-MILLS EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Industrial District Threshing-mills Employees' award, dated the 18th day of October, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 1062.

Tuesday, the 22nd day of December, 1925.

UPON reading the application of the parties to the Otago and Southland Industrial District Threshing-mills Employees' award, dated the 18th day of October, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 1062, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 5 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act, 1921, and of every other power in that behalf thereto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. That the said award shall be and it is hereby amended—
  - (a.) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 thereof, and substituting the following subclause—“(a.) Workers employed in the Upper Clutha Valley, 1s. 9d. per hour and found; workers employed throughout the rest of the Otago and Southland Industrial District, 1s. 10d. per hour and found;” and
  - (b.) By extending the date of the expiry of the said award to the 23rd day of September, 1927.
2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
