

(8123.) AUCKLAND ABATTOIR ASSISTANTS. — AMENDMENT OF
AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Auckland Abattoir Assistants' award, dated the 30th day of December, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxv, p. 1485.

Wednesday, the 18th day of March, 1925.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section 92 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Auckland Abattoir Assistants' award, dated the 30th day of December, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards,

Vol. xxv, p. 1485, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. The following sentence shall be added to subclause (g) of clause 3 of the said award: "All pigs mechanically scudded shall be paid for at above hand rates, less 4d. per pig."

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
