

(8133.) CANTERBURY FURNITURE TRADE.—AMENDMENT OF
APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923 ; and in the matter of the Canterbury Furniture Trade apprenticeship order, dated the 24th day of November, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxv, p. 1216.

Wednesday, the 18th day of March, 1925.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on the Court by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, this Court, upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the Apprenticeship Committee set up for the Canterbury Industrial District in connection with the furniture trade, and being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said order, doth hereby order that the said order shall be amended in manner following, that is to say :—

1. Clause 2 of the said order shall be amended by deleting the word “casketmaking.”

2. This order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
