(10223.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND CARPENTERS AND JOINERS.— AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Carpenters and Joiners' apprenticeship order, dated the 6th day of November, 1925, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVA, p. 1000.

Monday, the 30th day of November, 1931.

WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas the Apprenticeship Committee set up in connection with the carpentering and joinery industry in that portion of the Otago and Southland Industrial District which comprises the Boroughs of Oamaru and Hampden and the Waitaki County has made 396

application to the Court for an amendment of the Otago and Southland Carpenters and Joiners' apprenticeship order, dated the 6th day of November, 1925, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVA, p. 1000, as amended by an order dated the 1st day of May, 1930, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXX, p. 238: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows :---

1. That the said apprenticeship order, as amended by the said order dated the 1st day of May, 1930, in so far as it relates to that portion of the Otago and Southland Industrial District which comprises the Boroughs of Oamaru and Hampden and the Waitaki County, shall be amended by striking out from the tenth line of clause 9 thereof the figures "75" and substituting therefor the figures "70," and by adding the following proviso to the said clause 9: "Provided also that he obtains at least a 60-per-cent. pass at each term examination."

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
