

NORTHERN (AUCKLAND) INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

(10225.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT PRINTING TRADE.—
AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Printing Trade apprenticeship order, dated the 18th day of October, 1926, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVI, p. 1102.

Monday, the 30th day of November, 1931.

WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas the Apprenticeship Committee set up in connection with the printing trade in the Northern Industrial District has made application to the Court for an amendment of the Northern Industrial District Printing Trade apprenticeship order, dated the 18th day of October, 1926, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVI, p. 1102: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said order shall be amended by inserting the following clause after clause 6 thereof:—

“6A. An employer may not accept for training or additional tuition, whether outside of ordinary business hours or not, an apprentice who is bound to another employer unless the permission of the Apprenticeship Committee shall have first been obtained. Where there exists in a town or district adequate facilities for the training in any technical school of apprentices in the trade to which they are bound, or any allied trade, then the Apprenticeship Committee shall give first preference to such school in all cases in which additional training is desired. The training or additional tuition hereinbefore referred to is not to be deemed to include a transfer of an apprentice or a contract to perform work (with or without remuneration) to or for such first-mentioned employer.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
