In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District (except Hawke's Bay) Builders', Contractors', and General Labourers' award, dated the 12th day of September, 1930, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXX, p. 681.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Wellington Industrial District (except Hawke's Bay) Builders', Contractors', and General Labourers' award, dated the 12th day of September, 1930, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXX, p. 681, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order as follows:—
