

(10085.) NORTHERN, TARANAKI, WELLINGTON, NELSON, CANTERBURY, AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND ENGINEERS, MOULDERS, BOILERMAKERS, IRON SHIP AND BRIDGE BUILDERS.—ADDING PARTIES TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Nelson, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Engineers, Moulders, Boilermakers, Iron Ship and Bridge Builders' award, dated the 16th day of July, 1929, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXIX, p. 492.

UPON reading the application of the association of workers party to the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Nelson, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Engineers, Moulders, Boilermakers, Iron Ship and Bridge Builders' award, dated the 16th day of July, 1929, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXIX, p. 492, which application was filed herein on the 25th day of September, 1930, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the said association and such of the persons, firms, and companies hereinafter named as appeared either in person or by their representative duly appointed, this Court doth order as follows:—

1. That the following be and they are hereby added as parties to the said award:—

Standard Engineering Co., Ltd., 165 Taranaki Street, Wellington.

Wellington Mechanical Engineering Co., corner of Tory and Vivian Streets, Wellington.

Willerton Engineering Co., corner of Molesworth and Aitken Streets, Wellington.

2. That the following be and they are hereby added as parties to the said award on the understanding that the award shall not apply to or affect men engaged in the installation and maintenance of petrol-pumps:—

Atlantic Oil Co., Ltd., Dominion Buildings, Mercer Street, Wellington.

The Texas Co. (Australasia), Ltd., D.I.C. Building, Lambton Quay, Wellington.

Vacuum Oil Co. Proprietary, Ltd., T. and G. Buildings, Lambton Quay, Wellington.

3. That Fisher, D. P., Engineer, 22 Wigan Street, Wellington, be and he is hereby added as a party to the said award, subject to the following special conditions: The said D. P. Fisher is exempted from

all the provisions of the said award so long as he pays his journeymen moulders not less than the wages prescribed by this award, and does not engage in work substantially different from that now carried on. In all other respects the conditions for journeymen moulders shall be those of the Metal-workers' Assistants' award.

4. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
