

(10123.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT ELECTRICAL WORKERS (ELECTRIC-POWER BOARDS, ETC.).—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Electrical Workers' (Electric-power Boards, &c.) award, dated the 17th day of December, 1930, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXX, p. 979.

Thursday, the 30th day of April, 1931.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Northern Industrial District Electrical Workers' (Electric-power Boards, &c.) award, dated the 17th day of December, 1930, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXX, p. 979, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by adding the following to subclause (a) of clause 3 thereof: "and shall be worked between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. on the first five days, and 8 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturdays."

2. That the said award shall be further amended by adding the following to subclause (b) of clause 3 thereof: "and shall be worked between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 5 p.m. on the first five days, and 7.30 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturdays."

3. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
