

(10130.) NEW ZEALAND WATERSIDE WORKERS.—STRIKING OUT
PARTY FROM AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the New Zealand Waterside Workers' award, dated the 1st day of October, 1929, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXIX, p. 646.

Tuesday, the 11th day of August, 1931.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the New Zealand Waterside Workers' award, dated the 1st day of October, 1929, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXIX, p. 646, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. That the said award shall be amended by striking out from the list of parties thereto the name of—

Burns, John, and Co., Iron-merchants, Customs Street East,
Auckland.

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
