

(10133.) NEW ZEALAND (EXCEPT MARLBOROUGH) MOTOR MECHANICS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Nelson, Westland, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the New Zealand (except Marlborough) Motor Mechanics' award, dated the 30th day of November, 1928, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVIII, p. 873.

Wednesday, the 24th day of June, 1931.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the New Zealand (except Marlborough) Motor Mechanics' award, dated the 30th day of November, 1928, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVIII, p. 873, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by adding the following paragraph to subclause (d) of clause 18 thereof:—

“The provisions of the general order amending awards, agreements, and apprenticeship orders, dated the 29th day of May, 1931, shall not apply to assistants engaged before the 8th day of June, 1931.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have operated and taken effect on and from the 8th day of June, 1931.
