

(10148.) SOUTHLAND BUTCHERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments ; and in the matter of the Southland Butchers' award, dated the 1st day of November, 1927, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVII, p. 1068.

Tuesday, the 11th day of August, 1931.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties to the Southland Butchers' award, dated the 1st day of November, 1927, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVII, p. 1068, which application was filed herein on the 29th day of July, 1931, this Court, in pursuance and

exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (c) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by striking out “7.30 a.m.” from the ninth line and “noon” from the tenth line of sub-clause (a) of clause 1 thereof, and inserting in lieu thereof “8 a.m.” and “12.30 p.m.” respectively.

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
