

(10168.) NORTHERN, TARANAKI, WELLINGTON, CANTERBURY,
AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND BOOT OPERATIVES. — PARTIAL
EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts. — In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Finance Act, 1931; and in the matter of the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Boot Operatives' award, dated the 13th day of September, 1930, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXX, p. 764.

Thursday, the 10th day of September, 1931.

ON the application of the New Zealand Federated Boot Trade Industrial Association of Workers, party to the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Boot Operatives' award, dated the 13th day of September, 1930, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXX, p. 764, and after hearing the respective parties to the said award by their agents, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 18 of the Finance Act, 1931, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That female assistants employed under clause 13 of the said award on or before the 8th day of June, 1931, shall be excluded from the operation of the general order of the 29th May, 1931, made under the provisions of the Finance Act, 1931, in the same manner and to the same extent as if they were apprentices to the trade during their respective periods of assistantships.

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the 18th day of September, 1931.
