HOTELS EMPLOYEES.—ADDING PARTIES TO AWARD.

1. That the following be and they are hereby added as parties to the said award:—

That Scott, Mrs. W., "Tainui," Kawhia, shall be exempted from complying with the provisions of the award during the period commencing on 15th February and ending on 15th December, provided that during that period she restricts accommodation so as not to provide for more than fifteen lodgers at any time.
