

(10261.) NEW ZEALAND MARINE COOKS AND STEWARDS
(STEWARDS).—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the New Zealand Marine Cooks and Stewards (Stewards) award, dated the 19th day of November, 1931, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXI, p. 355.

Monday, the 11th day of April, 1932.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the New Zealand Marine Cooks and Stewards (Stewards) award, dated the 19th day of November, 1931, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXI, p. 355, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by adding to clause 1 thereof the following subclause:—

“(e) Subject to the provisions of the General Order of the Court dated the 29th day of May, 1931, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXI, p. 145, the monthly rate of pay and conditions of employment prescribed in the New Zealand Marine Cooks and Stewards (Coastal Shipping Companies) award, dated the 31st day of March, 1931, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXI, p. 115, shall apply to the steward on the s.s. ‘Waimea’ in lieu of the provisions of this award.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the 1st day of May, 1932.
