(10285.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND (WEST AND SOUTH OF MOLYNEUX RIVER) TIMBER-YARDS AND SAWMILLS EMPLOYEES.—EXTENDING SCOPE OF AWARD AND ADDING PARTIES.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments ; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland (West and South of Molyneux River) Timber-yards and Sawmills Employees' award, dated the 28th day of August, 1928, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVIII, p. 645.

UPON reading the application of the union party to the Otago and Southland (West and South of Molyneux River) Timber-yards and Sawmills Employees' award, dated the 28th day of August, 1928, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVIII, p. 645, which application was filed herein on the 6th day of May, 1932, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the said union and such of the persons, firms, and companies hereinafter named as appeared either in person or by their representative duly appointed, this Court, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (b) of the

Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. That the scope of the said award is hereby extended to cover the Southland Provincial District, including Stewart Island, and that portion of the Otago Provincial District lying south and west of the Taieri River.
