

(10298.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND PAINTERS AND DECORATORS.—  
AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments ; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Painters and Decorators' apprenticeship order, dated the 21st day of November, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxv, p. 1294.

Monday, the 29th day of August, 1932.

WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas the Apprenticeship Committee set up in connection with the painting and decorating industry in that part of the Otago and Southland Industrial District which is included in the Southland, Wallace, Fiord, and Stewart Island Counties, and the Kingston Riding of Lake County, has made application to the Court for an amendment of the Otago and Southland Painters and Decorators' apprenticeship order, dated the 21st day of November, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxv, p. 1294, as amended by an order dated the 9th day of July, 1930, and recorded in Book of Awards,

Vol. xxx, p. 711 : Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. That the said apprenticeship order, as amended by the order of the 9th day of July, 1930, in so far as it affects that part of the Otago and Southland Industrial District which is included in the Southland, Wallace, Fiord, and Stewart Island Counties, and the Kingston Riding of Lake County, shall be amended by deleting clause 8 thereof, and substituting the following clause therefor :—

“ 8. The minimum rates of wages payable to apprentices shall be 10s. per week for the first year, 15s. per week for the second year, £1 per week for the third year, £1 5s. per week for the fourth year, and £1 10s. per week for the fifth year.”

2. That this order shall apply only to apprenticeships commencing on and after the 1st day of September, 1932.

3. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the 1st day of September, 1932.
