

(10544.) WELLINGTON (FIFTY-MILES RADIUS) PAINTERS AND DECORATORS.—AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington (Fifty-miles Radius) Painters and Decorators' apprenticeship order, dated the 26th day of August, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 779, as amended by an order dated the 1st day of June, 1927, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVII, p. 428.

Monday, the 16th day of October, 1933.

WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas the Apprenticeship Committee set up in connection with the painting and decorating trade in that part of the Wellington Industrial District lying within a radius of fifty miles from the General Post Office at Wellington has made application to the Court for an amendment of the Wellington (Fifty-miles Radius) Painters and Decorators' apprenticeship order, dated the 26th day of August, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 779, as amended by an order dated the 1st day of June, 1927, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVII, p. 428: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said apprenticeship order, as amended by an order dated the 1st day of June, 1927, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVII, p. 428, shall be amended by striking out from the third line of clause 9 thereof the word "three," and substituting therefor the word "four."

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
