(10546.) WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT DAIRY-FACTORY MANAGERS.—AGREEMENT UNDER LABOUR DISPUTES INVESTIGATION ACT, 1913.

This agreement, made between the New Zealand Dairy-factory Managers' Association (as such association and as acting for the purposes of this agreement on behalf of the dairy-factory managers of the Wellington Industrial District) and the Wellington Industrial Union of Dairy-factory Employers, whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the said parties as follows:—

1. That the terms and conditions in the schedule filed with the Clerk of Awards on the 29th day of December, 1932, shall be the terms and conditions of employment of cheese- and butter-factory

managers throughout the Wellington Industrial District.

2. That this agreement shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st August, 1933, and shall continue in force until the 31st July, 1934.
