(10575.) NELSON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT PLUMBERS AND GASFITTERS.—AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Nelson Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Nelson Industrial District Plumbers and Gasfitters' apprenticeship order, dated the 23rd day of March, 1926, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVI, p. 163.

Wednesday, the 6th day of December, 1933.

WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas the Apprenticeship Committee set up in

connection with the plumbing and gasfitting industry in the Nelson Industrial District has made application to the Court for an amendment of the Nelson Industrial District Plumbers and Gasfitters' apprenticeship order, dated the 23rd day of March, 1926, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVI, p. 163 : Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. That the said order shall be amended by striking out clause 8 thereof, and substituting the following clause therefor :—

“ 8. The minimum rates of wages payable to apprentices shall be : 12s. 6d. per week for the first year ; 18s. per week for the second year ; £1 5s. per week for the third year ; £1 12s. 6d. per week for the fourth year ; £2 per week for the fifth year ; and £2 10s. per week for the sixth year.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
