(10409.) WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT DAIRY-FACTORY MANAGERS.—AGREEMENT UNDER LABOUR DISPUTES INVESTI-GATION ACT, 1913.

This agreement, made between the New Zealand Dairy-factory Managers' Association (as such association and as acting for the purpose of this agreement on behalf of the dairy-factory managers of the Wellington Industrial District) and the Wellington Industrial Union of Dairy-factory Employers, whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the said parties as follows:—

The terms and conditions in the schedule hereunder shall be the terms of employment of cheese and butter factory managers throughout

the Wellington Industrial District.

- 1. General factory-managers' salaries to be assessed on the total output of the company.
- 2. The output of dual-plant factories shall be assessed on the basis of 10 lb. milk to 1 lb. cheese, or 1 lb. butterfat to 1·2 lb. butter and/or 2·5 lb. cheese.
- 3. In the event of any factory changing from the manufacture of cheese to butter during the currency of any season, output shall be assessed on the basis of $2\frac{1}{2}$ lb. of cheese to 1 lb. butterfat.
- 4. General managers to be provided with free motor transit and the running-expenses of same and/or extra money allowance to cover costs of superintending work of branch factories.
- 5. Factory manager and/or branch manager shall be provided with a suitable modern residence and usual perquisites, consisting of cheese, milk, and fuel in cheese-factories, and butter, milk, and fuel in butter-factories, and shall be allowed a fortnight's holiday each year.
- 6. Term of Agreement.—This agreement shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st of December, 1932, and shall continue in force until the 31st July, 1933.
- 7. Disputes and exceptional cases shall be placed before a tribunal consisting of two members appointed by the New Zealand Dairy Co. Managers' Association, and two members appointed by the Wellington Industrial Union of Dairy Employers for decision.
