

(10412.) NORTHERN (EXCEPT GISBORNE JUDICIAL DISTRICT), WELLINGTON (EXCEPT HAWKE'S BAY), AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND SHOP-ASSISTANTS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern (except Gisborne Judicial District), Wellington (except Hawke's Bay), and Otago and Southland Shop-assistants' award, dated the 29th day of September, 1932, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXII, p. 196.

Wednesday, the 22nd day of March, 1933.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties for amendment of the Northern (except Gisborne Judicial District), Wellington (except Hawke's Bay), and Otago and Southland Shop-assistants' award, dated the 29th day of September, 1932, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXII, p. 196; and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said parties, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 92 (1) (c) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by striking out from the fourth line of subclause (c) of clause 12 thereof the word " Marton "; and by striking out from the seventh line of subclause (c) of clause 12 thereof the word " four," and substituting therefor the word " three."

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
