(10422.) NEW ZEALAND (EXCEPT MARLBOROUGH) CARPENTERS AND JOINERS.—PARTIAL EXEMPTION FROM AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Taranaki Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the New Zealand (except Marlborough) Carpenters and Joiners' award, dated the 22nd day of December, 1932, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXII, p. 636.

Wednesday, the 22nd day of March, 1933.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the New Zealand (except Marlborough) Carpenters and Joiners' award, dated the 22nd day of December, 1932, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXII, p. 636, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the Taranaki Hospital Board is hereby exempted from the observance of the provisions of the said award in respect only of one worker regularly employed by it.

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day

of the date hereof.
