

(10460.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND PLUMBERS AND GASFITTERS.—
AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments ; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Plumbers and Gasfitters' Apprenticeship Order, dated the 22nd day of December, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 1752.

Monday, the 22nd day of May, 1933.

WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act : And whereas the Southland Plumbers and Gasfitters' Apprenticeship Committee has made application to the Court for an amendment of the Otago and Southland Plumbers and Gasfitters' Apprenticeship Order, dated the 22nd day of December, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 1752 : Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. That the said order, in so far as it affects that part of the Otago and Southland Industrial District which is included in the Southland Provincial District, shall be amended by striking out clause 8 thereof, and substituting therefor the following clause :—

“ 8. The minimum rates of wages payable to apprentices shall be 10s. per week for the first year, 15s. per week for the second year, 20s. per week for the third year, 25s. per week for the fourth year, 30s. per week for the fifth year, and 40s. per week for the sixth year.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
