

NORTHERN (AUCKLAND) INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

(10601.) AUCKLAND (TWENTY-ONE MILES RADIUS) BUTCHERS.—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Auckland (Twenty-one Miles Radius) Butchers' award, dated the 10th day of November, 1933, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXIII, p. 1016.

Wednesday, the 28th day of March, 1934.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Auckland (Twenty-one Miles Radius) Butchers' award, dated the 10th day of November, 1933, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXIII, p. 1016, this Court, being of opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by adding the following subclause to clause 3 thereof:—

“(b) Except as provided in subclauses (c) and (e) of clause 1, no work shall be done before 6 a.m. or after 5.30 p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays, or before 5 a.m. on Saturdays.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
