

(10626.) GISBORNE JUDICIAL DISTRICT, WANGANUI-RANGITIKEI DISTRICT, AND NELSON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT MOTOR AND HORSE DRIVERS.—STRIKING OUT PARTY TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Gisborne Judicial District, Wanganui-Rangitikei District, and Nelson Industrial District Motor and Horse Drivers' award, dated the 2nd day of October, 1933, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXIII, p. 925.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on the Court by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Gisborne Judicial District, Wanganui-Rangitikei District, and Nelson Industrial District Motor and Horse Drivers' award, dated the 2nd day of October, 1933, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXIII, p. 925, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. That the said award shall be amended by striking out from the list of parties thereto the name of—

McKinley and Co., Grocers, Gladstone Road, Gisborne.

2. That this order shall be deemed to have operated and taken effect as from the 9th day of October, 1933.
